### More information:

- Any wage levels with brackets will vary depending on role, age, size of camp, experience/qualifications
  and previous performance if applicable (1:1 wage levels will also depend on hours worked and the needs
  of the child)
- The third general staff wage level only applies to staff <u>contracted</u> into the Multi Activity or Fencing role. If you are simply trained in this role it will not apply
- All general staff receive a 20 minute lunch break & 15 minute rest break either in the morning or afternoon regardless of working early and late clubs
- All senior staff receive a total of 30 minutes break per day
- Roaming staff are paid their normal rate plus additional travel expenses to and from their base camp.
   For example, if you are 21-24 with a Barracudas training course, you will be on £79.00 per day and also receive travel expenses worked out to and from your base camp
- All employees begin to accrue annual leave from their first day of work. Due to the short term of the employment with Barracudas and the limitations to take any annual leave, all annual leave payments are already included in the hourly rate displayed above
- The pay grades set overleaf are gross amounts which are subject to the individual tax and NI contributions
