

Magic and Monster Corner



Bookmarks

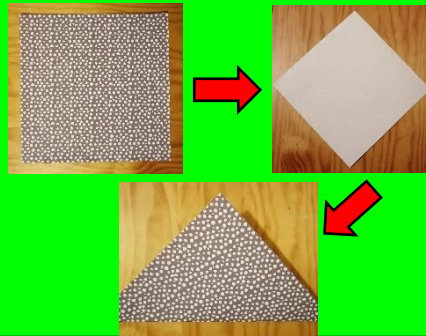
You will need:

- Origami or coloured paper (15cm x 15cm)
- White and coloured card
- Glue and scissors
- A 1p coin as a template for the eyes, or googly eyes
- A pen and pencil



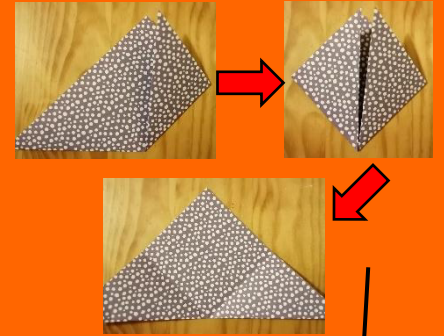
Step 1:

Take your piece of origami paper and turn it over
Fold the two corners together so it looks a bit like a hat



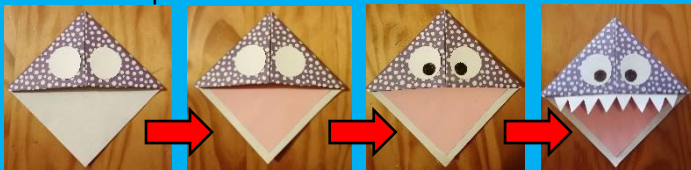
Step 2:

Fold the right-hand corner up so it touches the tip of the triangle, and do the same with the other side to form a small square
Open it out again so you can clearly see the fold lines



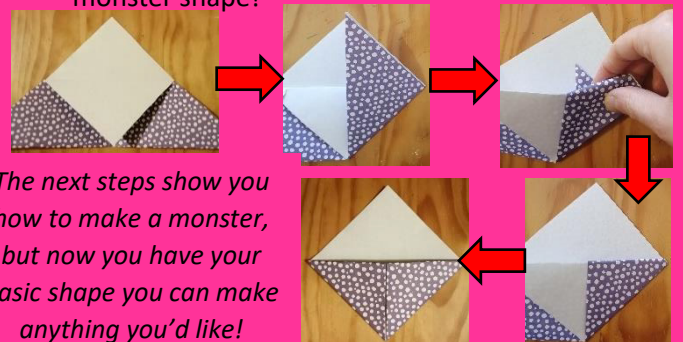
Step 4: Decorate your bookmark!

First, use your 1p coin as a template to make two eyes, and stick them on. (You could also use googly eyes if you'd prefer).
Then, for the mouth, cut out a square piece of card and cut it down until it is the right fit to slide into your bookmark, and glue it down. Make sure to draw some pupils onto your eyes as well!
Next, from a white piece of card, cut out a set of sharp teeth to attach to your monster – it is now complete!



Step 3:

Fold the top of the triangle down so it sits in the fold lines you've already made
Fold the right-hand side of the triangle up so it touches the top tip of the original shape and creates a new triangle
Then with your fingers, fold down the top of this new triangle and tuck it underneath the bottom section
Repeat with the other side - now you have your monster shape!



The next steps show you how to make a monster, but now you have your basic shape you can make anything you'd like!

Now your monster bookmark is all done!
You can make lots of different bookmarks using this method, and can use more card, feathers and glitter to make anything you want!
