

## Quilling


Paper Quilling is the art of taking thin strips of paper of varying widths and rolling, gluing and shaping them into different shapes.

What you'll need:

- Paper or card
- Glue (ideally a glue stick but PVA also works)
- Scíssors
- A pen or pencil to wrap your paper strips round to curl them








- 2. Cut thin strips of paper in different colours.
- 3. Wrap the strips of paper around a pen or pencil to make a coil. Slip the coil off the end of the pen, keeping the coiled shape. Glue the end of the paper coil down so that it stays in a coiled shape.
- Experiment with making different shapes by pinching one end to create a teardrop shape or pinching both ends of the coils to get an eye shape.
- Stick your shapes down onto your base card, following the design you drew out earlier.







## Paper

**IOP IIP**: use a pen or pencil with a rounded rather than an angled edge to wrap your paper strips around.
